Dear KIPP Tulsa Community,

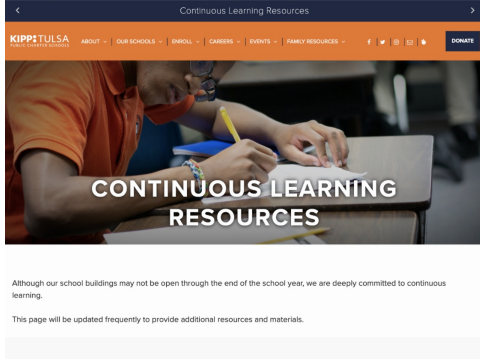
Thank you to everyone who has reached out to check on KIPP Tulsa and our families. Your support means the world to all of us.
